

State Competitiveness (1)

Single Sales Factor & Corporate Income Tax (NCEJA)

• Elective Single Sales Factor:

 Allows companies to pay tax on only the income from sales within the state (25 other states currently have a single sales factor)

Corporate Income Tax Reduction:

 Reduce the CIT from 7.6% (2nd highest in nation) to 4.9% over a four-year period to match Personal Income Tax rate



State Competitiveness (1b)

- New Century Economy Jobs Agenda
 - Job Training Incentive Program:
 - HB7: Increases funding of \$4.75 million in FY14
 - "Do Pass" from House Business & Industry Committee
 - Tabled by House Appropriations & Finance Committee (Feb 18), because the \$4.75 million is also appropriated in HB2 (General Appropriations Bill)
 - Local Economic Development Act:

- HB352: Places local clawback provisions on the proposed \$10
 million of LEDA funds for FY14
- "Do Pass, as amended" from House Business & Industry Committee
- "Do Pass, as amended" from House Taxation & Revenue Committee
- Passed House 69–0, referred to Senate Finance and Senate Corporations & Transportation Committees



State Competitiveness (2)

Informed Consent

- General Information:
 - Extends protections currently granted to operators to suppliers and manufacturers; extends sunset clause to 2021
 - SB240: Passed Senate 34-0, currently awaits vote in House Business & Industry Committee
 - HB308: Passed House 70-0, currently awaits vote in Senate Public Affairs Committee to be heard March 5th.
 - One bill must pass for final signing by Governor



State Competitiveness (3)

Border Zone Company Gross Receipts

- General Information:
 - Extends the sunset clause on GRT exemption for tradesupport companies located within 20 miles from a New Mexico Port of Entry from June 2013 to June 2019
 - HB235:
 - Given "Do Pass" from House Business & Industry Committee with amendment that requires annual review of the amount of deductions and total number of companies claiming exemption
 - "Do Pass, as amended" from House Taxation & Revenue Committee
 - "Do Pass, as amended" from House Appropriations & Finance Committee
 - Passed House 65–0, referred to Senate for introduction




State Competitiveness (4)

- NM Partnership
 - General Information:
 - Dual approach to increase statewide economic development marketing efforts by \$250,000, bringing total NM Partnership budget to \$880,000
 - HB75: Business Attraction & Retention Program
 - "Do Pass" from House Business & Industry Committee
 - Referred to the House Appropriations & Finance Committee




Regional Growth






Business Development Progress to Date vs Last Year as of Feb. 15, 2013










