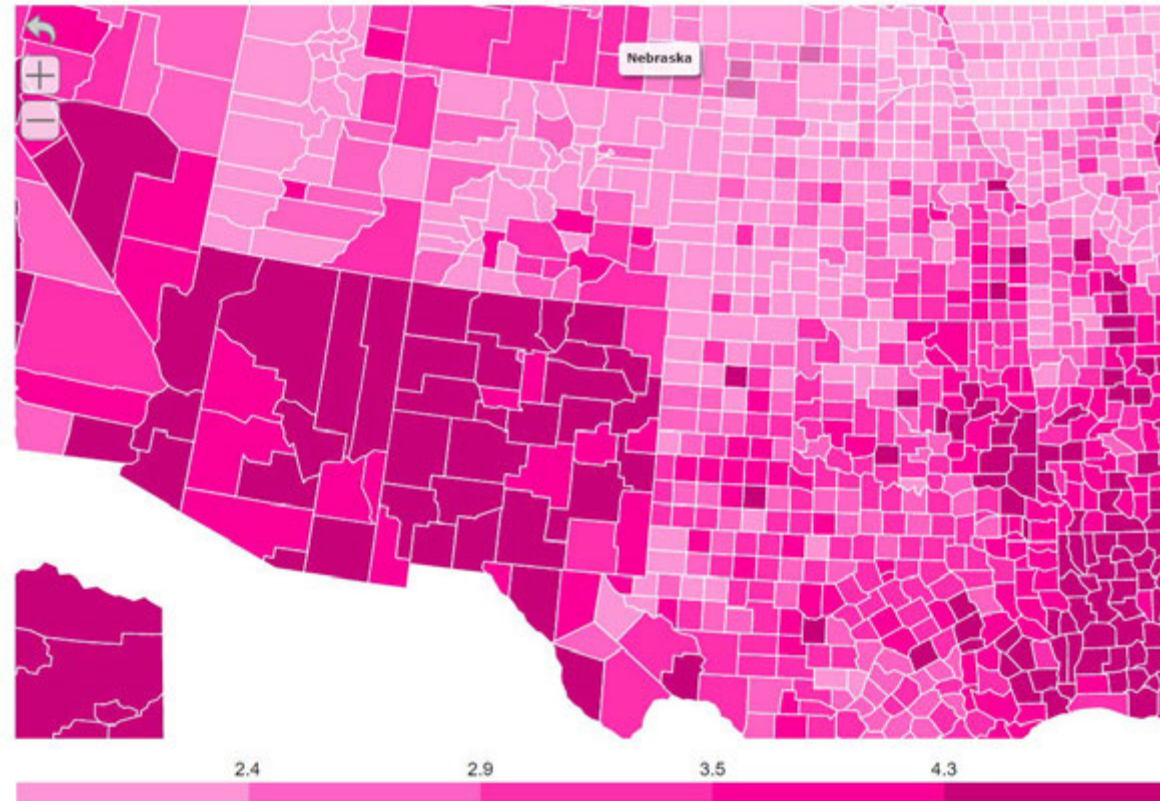
NM Employment Lags Behind US in All Categories

- WIOA funding can be used for
